## Soils team working On US-281 in Russell County

Starting today, and continuing for approximately two weeks, a soils section of a geotechnical unit with KDOT will be performing field investigations along US-281 Highway.

The geotechnical study will occur along the corridor beginning at the north city limits of Russell, and continuing north to K-18 Highway.

The investigations will require sections of the highway to be restricted to one lane traffic for approximately ½-mile sections during daylight hours.

The geotechnical study is intended to gather information that is necessary for the detailed design of the proposed improvement of this section of US-281, which was selected as one of the modernization projects in northwest Kansas. The modernization project will be funded by T-WORKS, the transportation program passed by the Kansas Legislature in May, of 2010.

The project is tentatively scheduled to begin in 2018.
