## Survey Scheduled for US-24 in Clay County

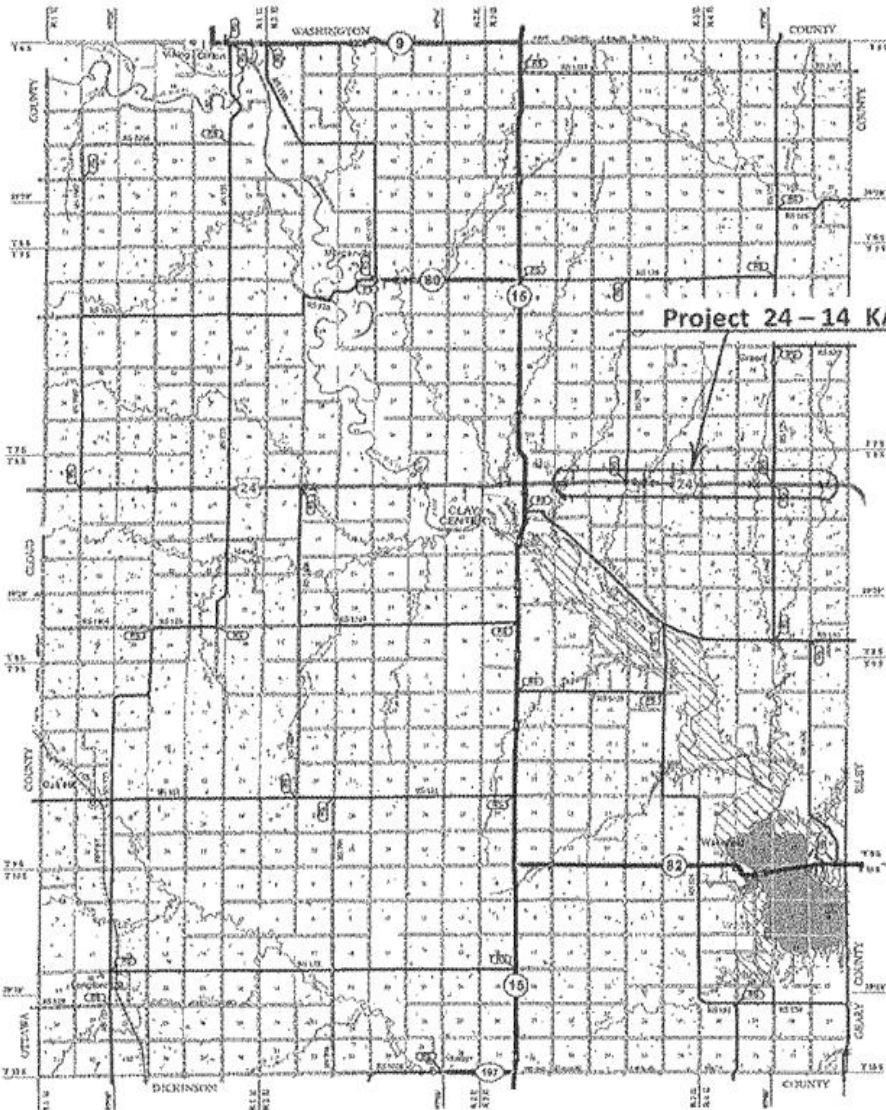
Surveyors will soon be conducting work on US-24 in preparation for improvements to guardrail and guard fence. Survey information will be gathered 300 ft. before/after existing installations between Clay Center and the Clay/Riley County line. The field survey is scheduled to begin Wednesday, Sept 25, 2013 and will be completed by November 20<sup>th</sup> weather permitting.

A member of the survey crew will first contact property owners and/or tenants for permission prior to entering private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.

Rob Selley, L.S., Field Survey Project Manager, will be in charge of this survey for the KDOT.

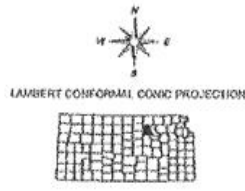
