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Survey Scheduled for US-77 in Geary County

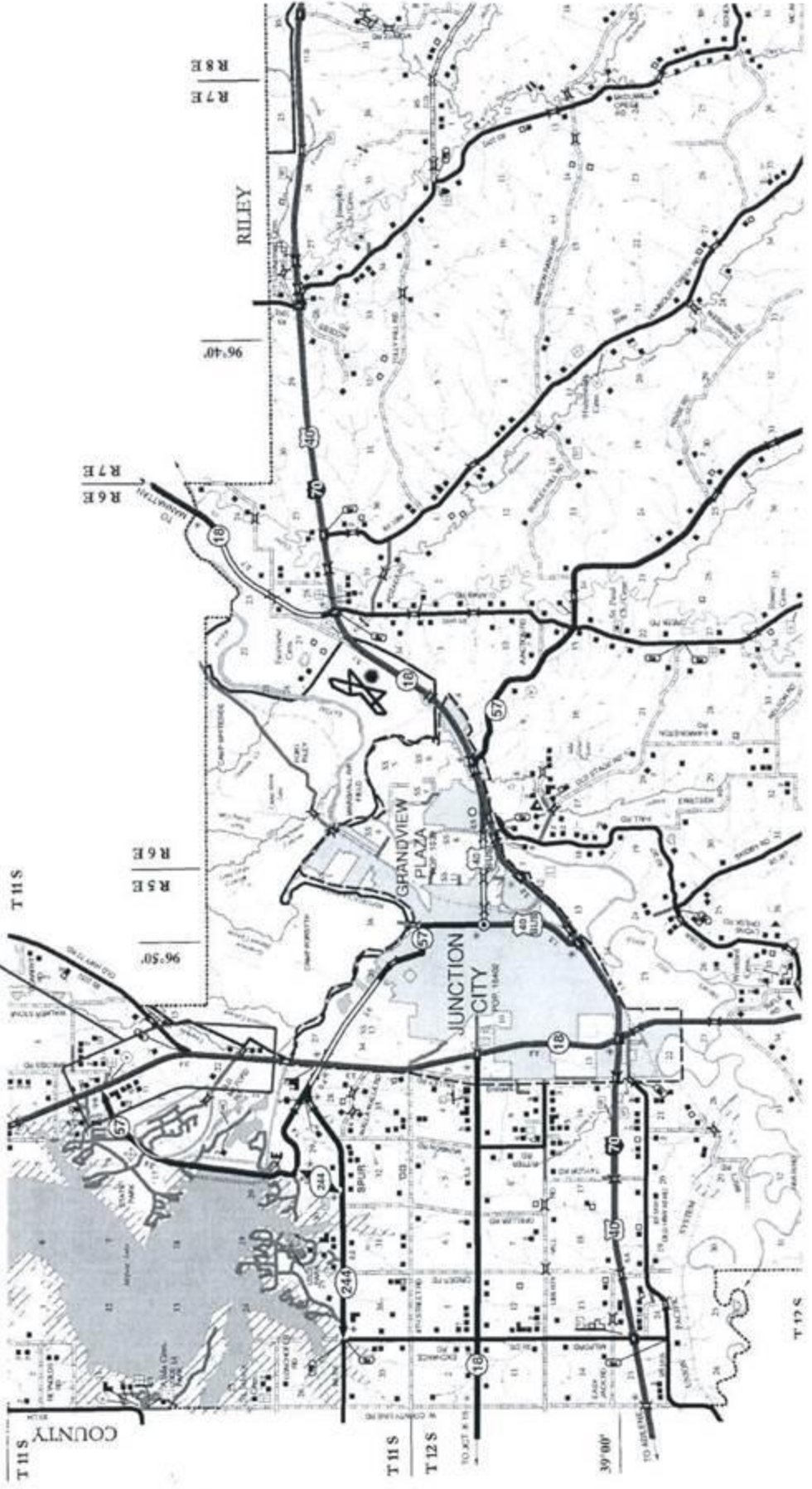
Surveyors will soon be conducting work on US-77 in preparation for a proposed reconstruction of US-77 including intersection improvements. The survey is designed to gather information necessary for the detailed design of the proposed improvements. The field survey will extend from the US-77/Old Milford Rd. intersection north to the north junction of K-57/US-77 a distance of three miles. The field survey is scheduled to begin Tuesday, Nov. 12, 2013 and will be completed by mid-February weather permitting.

A member of the survey crew will first contact property owners and/or tenants for permission prior to entering private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.

Chad McCullough, with the consultant firm of Kaw Valley Engineering, will be in charge of this survey for the KDOT.
