## For Friday/Thursday, July 30-August 19 in Lyon County

## US-50

Weather permitting, on Friday, July 30 at 7:00 a.m., a pavement marking removal and replacement project will begin on a 6.4-mile stretch of US-50. Project work will take place on eastbound and westbound US-50 from the Chase County line to .17 miles west of County Road F junction, then move .53-miles west of the County Road G/Americus Road junction to the Overlander Street junction in Lyon County.

Crews will work a minimum of 12 hours per day between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Work will begin on westbound US-50 and then move to the eastbound direction.

Flaggers will coordinate with pilot cars to guide traffic through the project work zone. Drivers should expect a maximum delay of fifteen minutes throughout the duration of the project. A 12-foot lane width restriction will be in place throughout the project work zone.

Project work is scheduled to be completed on Thursday, August 19, 2010, weather permitting.
