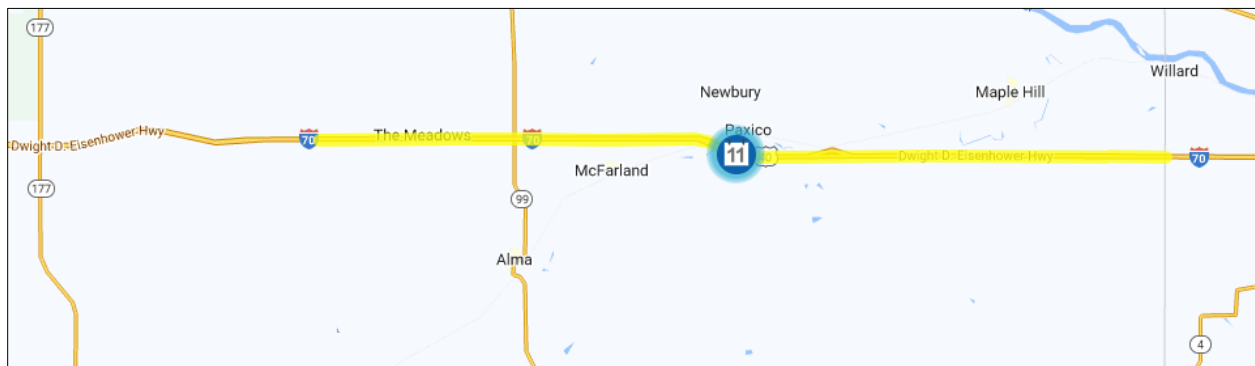
Patching work to resume in Wabaunsee County

A Kansas Department of Transportation project is expected to resume on I-70 in Wabaunsee County on Monday, Sept. 11, weather permitting. Additional patching work will be done between mile markers 324 and 342.

Crews will be working on both directions of I-70 in approximately 4-mile sections. The active work zone will be reduced to one lane and will have a reduced speed limit of 60 mph. A 12-foot width restriction will also be in place. On- and off-ramps will remain open.

Work will occur Monday through Friday during daylight hours and is expected to be complete by late October.
