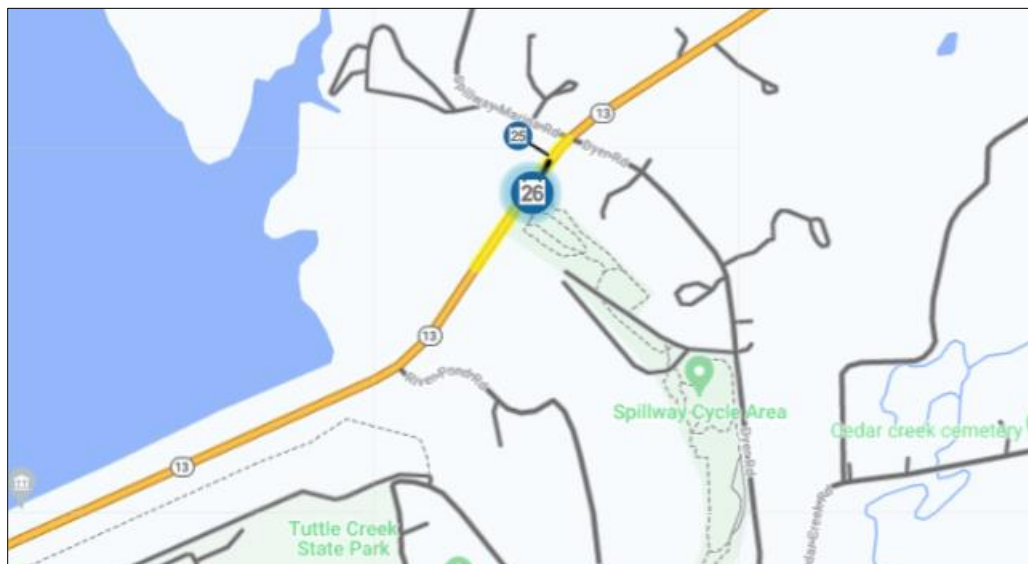

K-13/Spillway bridge to be reduced next week

The Spillway bridge on K-13 north of Manhattan will be reduced to one lane on Tuesday and Wednesday, April 25 and 26, from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., weather permitting. Kansas Department of Transportation maintenance crews will provide traffic control while bridge inspections are completed.

Flaggers will direct traffic through the area, which will be marked by signs and cones. Drivers should plan for delays of up to 15 minutes.
