## K-10 South Lawrence Trafficway Project to Begin in Lawrence

On **Tuesday, November 12,** a three-year construction project will begin to complete the six-mile four-lane K-10 South Lawrence Trafficway freeway. The project will move existing K-10 onto a new alignment that will begin at the south junction of the U.S. 59 and K-10 interchange and reconnect with existing K-10 in east Lawrence (Douglas County).

Construction work on the project will be completed in phases. Each phase includes specific work and advance notification will be sent under separate cover for each phase of construction, including planned traffic impacts. Starting on **Tuesday**, **November 12**, crews will begin clearing vegetation in preparation for grading work that will take place along the new Haskell Avenue alignment and possibly along the new Louisiana Street alignment. There will be minimal to no traffic impacts with this first phase as work is taking place off the existing roadway. Work will take place during daylight hours, Monday through Friday, with some occasional Saturday work.

Emery Sapp & Sons Inc. (Columbia, MO) is the primary contractor on this expansion project with a total contract cost of \$129.8 million. The overall scheduled completion date for the K-10 South Lawrence Trafficway project is Fall 2016.
