### 17th Street Bridge Over I-470 Resurfacing Project

**EXPECT DELAYS! 24/7 BRIDGE CLOSURE:** Eastbound and westbound 17th Street Bridge over I-470 will be **CLOSED**, 24/7 round the clock, for resurfacing work beginning at **6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 25 and reopening to unrestricted traffic by 6:00 a.m. on Friday, June 28**. Crews will be completing pavement repair and overlay work on the bridge deck. **The project start date was rescheduled from Monday, June 24 to Tuesday, June 25 due to forecasted rain for Monday evening.**

No marked detour provided. Drivers must use alternate routes during the bridge closure. Suggested alternate routes: 21<sup>st</sup> Street Bridge over I-470 or Huntoon Avenue.

The Kansas Department of Transportation urges all motorists to be alert, obey the warning signs, and "Give 'Em a Brake!" when approaching and driving through the project work zone.
