## **US-24 & Flush Road Intersection Public Information Meeting Scheduled**

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) is hosting a Public Information Meeting for the US-24 and Flush Road intersection in Pottawatomie County on **Monday, May 16 from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. at St. George Elementary School, 200 Blackjack Road in St. George.** At this public information meeting, KDOT staff will present the recently completed traffic study findings for the US-24 and Flush Road intersection, discuss potential short- and/or long-term solutions for the intersection, as well as provide meeting participants the opportunity to share their input and concerns about the intersection itself. We invite anyone interested in this intersection, including local stakeholders, businesses, and citizens, to attend this public information meeting.

In the meantime, KDOT crews will implement some additional traffic control measures at the US-24 and Flush Road intersection. Crews will re-grind the rumble strips located on southbound Flush Road, install a larger 48-inch wide stop sign (complete with flag) on the north leg of Flush Road, and add to the intersection pavement, painted rectangular stop bars, on the north and south legs of Flush Road as well as on the US-24 median crossover. These interim solutions will help enhance existing traffic control measures by providing drivers with more visual signage and pavement treatments to emphasize attention to traffic movements at the intersection. These added traffic control measures will be installed by Friday, April 22, weather permitting.
