**For Monday/Friday, October 11-15, 2010 in Brown & Nemaha Counties**

## US-36

Weather permitting, beginning **early morning on Monday, October 11**, US-36 may have two pilot car operations for resurfacing work underway on a 15-mile stretch from west US-36/K-63 junction east to the US-36/K-236 junction and from the US-36/K- 236 junction east to the Nemaha/Brown County line. A pilot car operation will be in place at both the east city limits of Seneca and between K-236 and the Brown/Nemaha County line. Both pilot car operations will move east as work progresses and at some point may be only four to five miles apart in distance.

Flaggers will coordinate with pilot cars to guide traffic through the project. Drivers should expect some delays of up to 30 minutes, including possible start and stop traffic, and are encouraged to use alternate routes, if possible. When drivers enter the project work zone on US-36 from adjacent roadways, they must not enter onto US-36 until they are able to follow in behind the pilot car.
