US-40/US-59 (Kansas River Bridge)

EXPECT MAJOR DELAYS! Northbound US-40/US-59 will be reduced to one lane over the Kansas River Bridge in Downtown Lawrence once again so crews can complete overlay work beginning at **9:00 a.m. on Monday, March 19.** Work will take place during the daylight hours only.

Beginning at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, March 19, crews will begin overlay work on the northbound bridge, which means more equipment and manpower will be on the bridge resulting in traffic traveling <u>much slower</u> during peak times especially causing the potential for increased delays. **Drivers should allow extra time or use alternate routes, if possible.**

This is work that remains from a bridge repair and resurfacing project that began in early August 2011. The project was suspended for winter shutdown in mid-November 2011

The overlay work on the northbound bridge is scheduled to be completed in **early** June 2012, weather permitting.
