For Thursday, March 15-Early April 2012 in Lawrence/Douglas County

US-59

EXPECT DELAYS! Beginning **mid-morning on Thursday, March 15**, northbound and southbound left lanes will be closed just north of 1100 Road, (approximately two miles south of Lawrence) for about 1,000-foot total each direction for pavement work. Crews will complete crossover pavement work for upcoming traffic changes related to the US-59 improvement project.

Work will take place during the daylight hours only. Drivers should expect minor delays and are advised to use caution when traveling through the project work zone.

The crossover pavement work on is scheduled to be completed in **early April 2012, weather permitting.**
