K-4 pavement marking planned in Shawnee, Jefferson counties

Pavement marking replacement on two sections of K-4 is scheduled to take place the week of April 25 in Shawnee and Jefferson counties, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT).

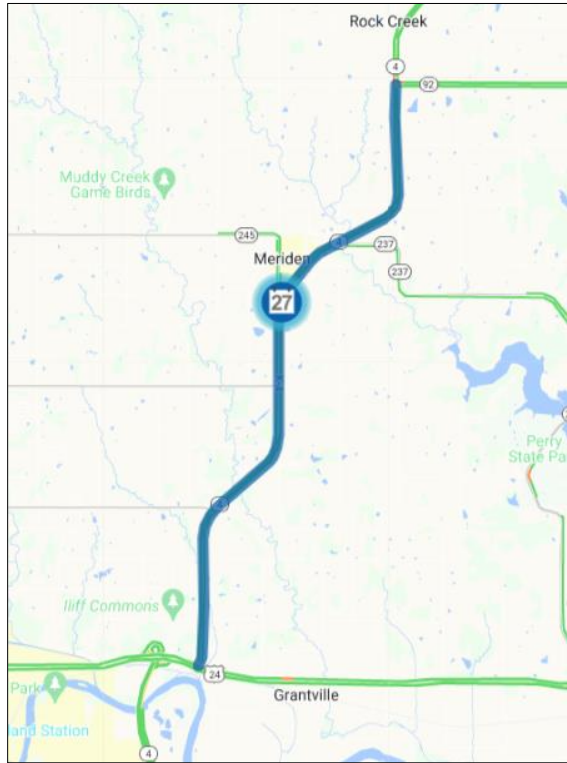
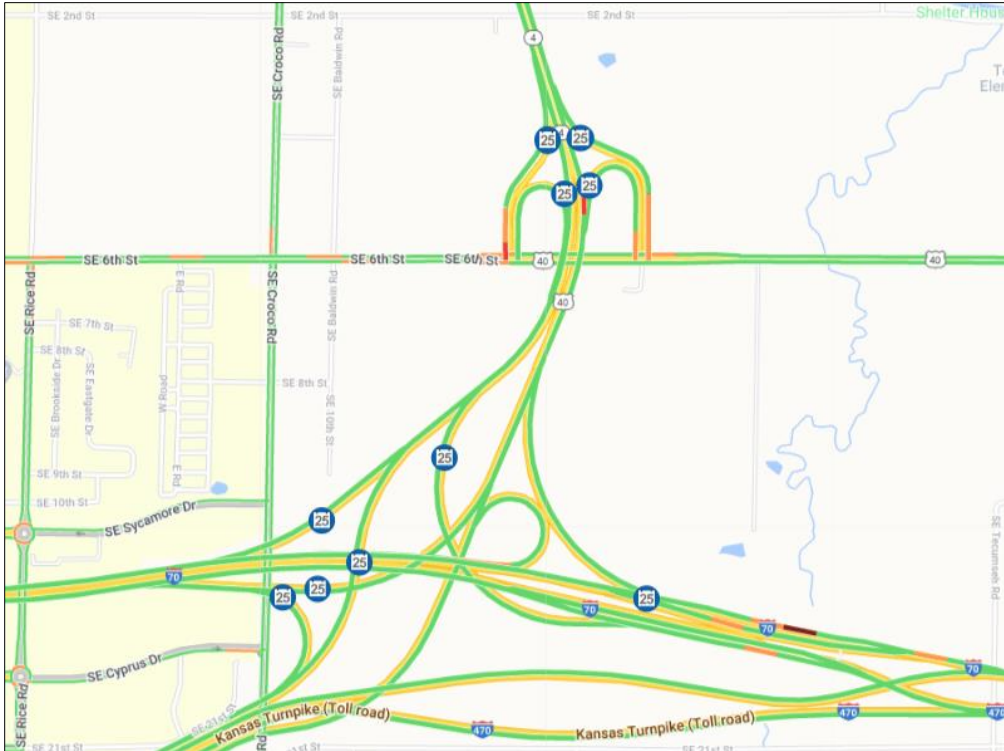
On Monday, April 25, contractors will replace pavement markings on all K-4 ramps to and from U.S. 40/Southeast 6th Avenue and I-70 in Topeka. Intermittent ramp closures will occur. Message boards are in place to notify drivers of closures. Work is expected to be completed by Thursday, April 28.

On Wednesday, April 27, contractors will begin on K-4 in Jefferson County, from U.S. 24 to K-92. Flaggers will direct traffic through the active work zone, which will be reduced to one lane. Drivers should plan for delays of up to 15 minutes. Work is expected to be completed by Saturday, April 30.

All work is weather permitting and will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Twin Traffic Marking Corp., of Kansas City, is completing the work.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas, go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1.
