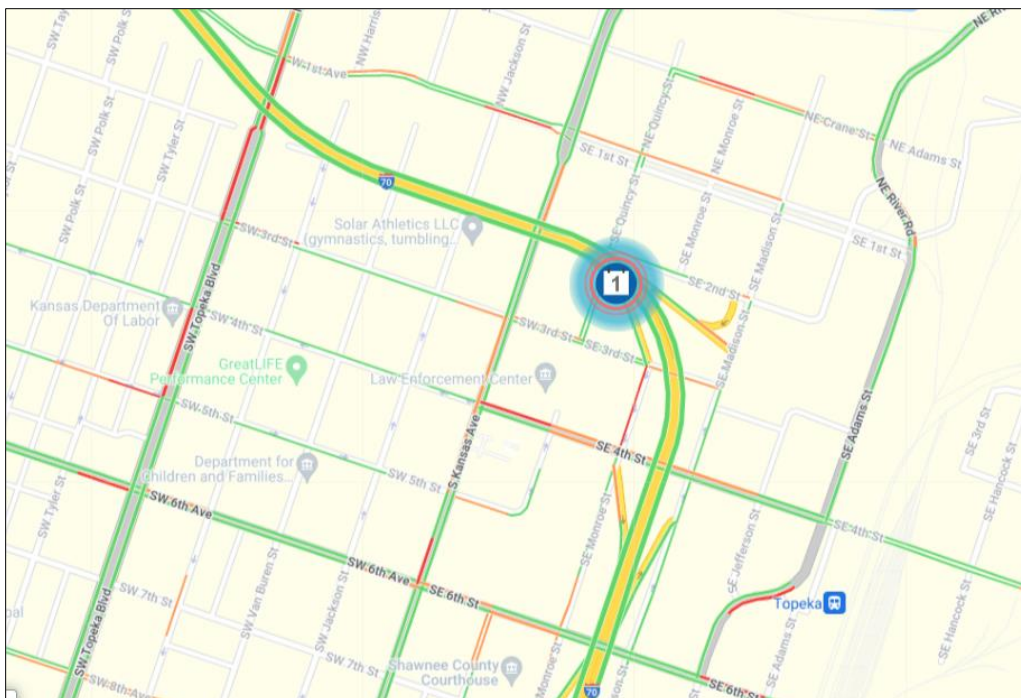

I-70 exit ramp closed in Topeka this week

According to the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT), the eastbound I-70 exit onto 3rd Street/Southeast Monroe Street in downtown Topeka will be closed this week while crews complete pavement repairs. The ramp will be closed Tuesday, March 1, through Thursday, March 3, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting.

The closure will be marked by barricades, signs and cones. No marked detour will be posted so drivers will need to find alternative routes, such as the 1st Street or 8th Street eastbound exit ramps.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas, go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1.
