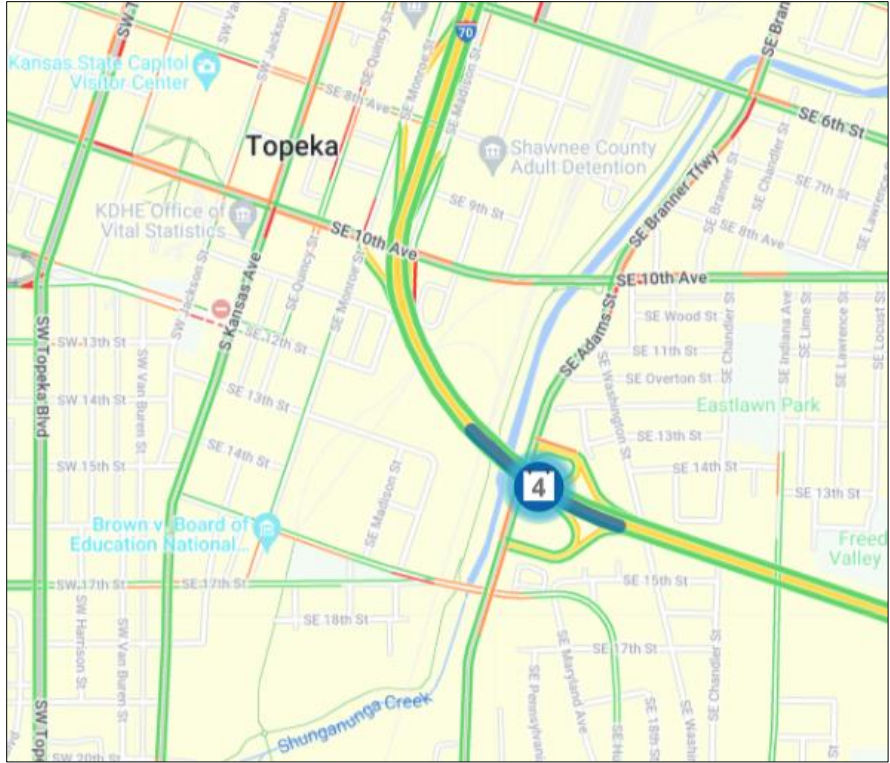
I-70 lane reduction scheduled in Topeka

According to the Kansas Department of Transportation, crews will complete barrier wall maintenance on I-70 in Topeka on Monday, April 4, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting.

The left lane of westbound I-70 will be closed from mile markers 362 to 363, approximately, or from Southeast Adams Street to south of Southeast 10th Avenue.

Drivers should be prepared for slow-moving traffic through the work zone, which will be marked by arrow boards, cones and signs.
