Southwest 37th Street in Topeka to be reduced Friday

The Kansas Department of Transportation maintenance crews will be conducting I-470 bridge inspections on Southwest 37th Street, between Wood Valley Drive and Randolph Avenue, in Topeka on Friday, May 20, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting.

Traffic on Southwest 37th Street will be one lane in each direction, with one direction utilizing the middle turn lane. Flaggers will direct drivers at Oak Parkway.

Signs and cones will mark the active work zone. Delays should be minimal, but drivers should be prepared for slow-moving traffic through the area.
