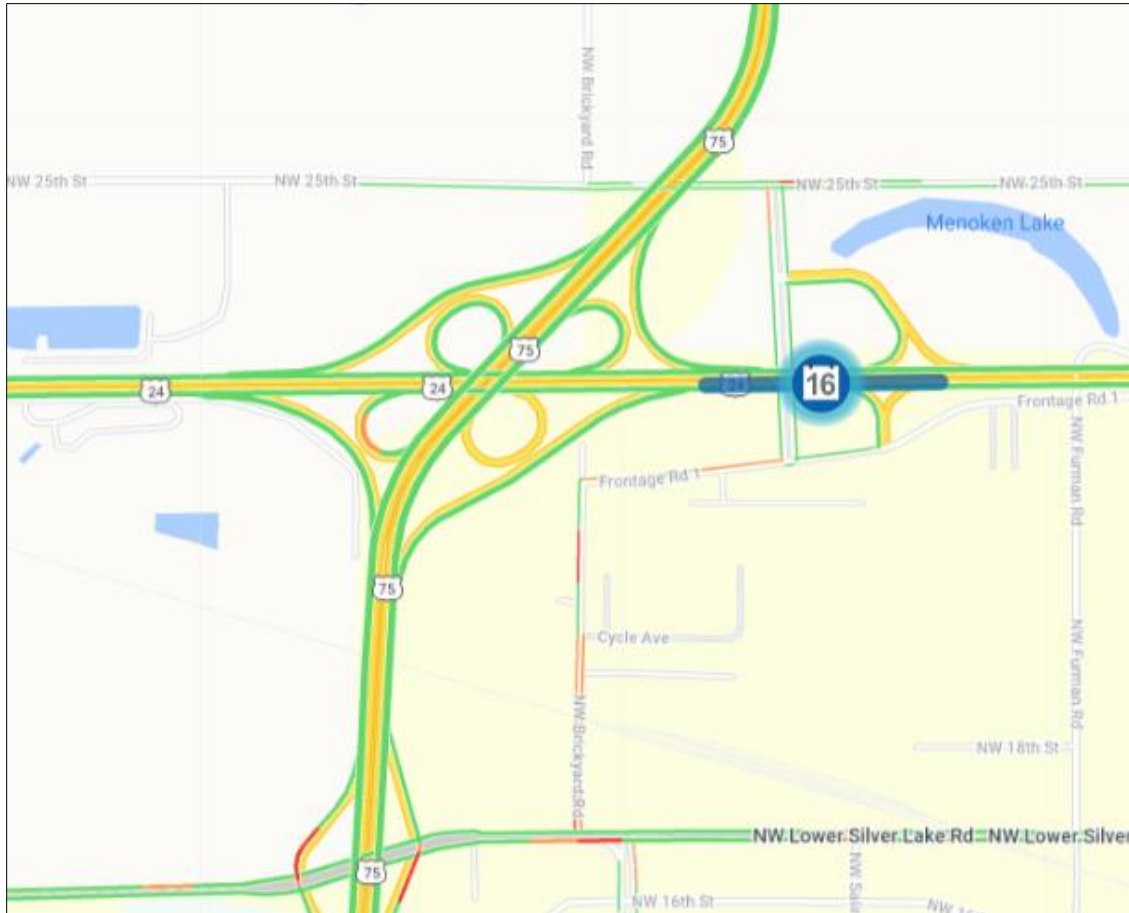
U.S. 24 lane closures scheduled Monday in Topeka

The Kansas Department of Transportation maintenance crews will be working on U.S. 24, just east of the U.S. 75 interchange, in Topeka on Monday, May 16, weather permitting.

Alternating lane closures will occur in the eastbound lanes from 9 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., and in the westbound lanes from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m. while crews complete bridge maintenance and inspection work. The eastbound exit ramp to Northwest 25th Street will also be closed in the morning.

Signs, cones and arrow boards will mark the active work zone. Delays should be minimal, but drivers should be prepared for slow-moving traffic through the area.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas, go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1.
