U.S. 59 guardrail project to begin in Douglas County

A guardrail project on northbound and southbound U.S. 59 south of Lawrence is scheduled to begin on Tuesday, April 5, weather permitting. Work will begin just south of 1200 Road and extend north less than one mile.

According to the Kansas Department of Transportation, there will be a lane closure on U.S. 59 where work is being completed. Advanced signing and cones will mark the work zone.

Bettis Asphalt & Construction, Inc., of Topeka, is the contractor on the \$221,000 project. Work is expected to be complete by late May.
