## I-470 exit ramp to close Monday in Topeka

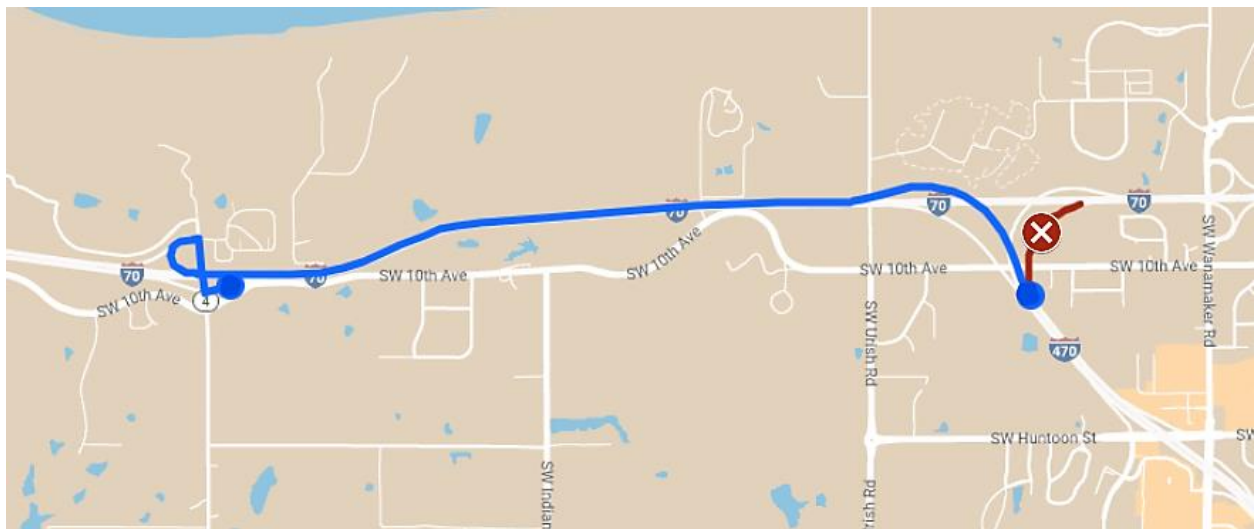
A Kansas Department of Transportation bridge repair project will close the exit ramp from westbound I-470 to eastbound I-70 in Topeka on Monday, Oct. 9, weather permitting.

The ramp will be closed to traffic for the duration of the project, which is expected to be complete by the end of October, conditions permitting.

Motorists can follow the marked detour to westbound I-70 and K-4/Auburn Road or use alternate routes. Drivers should plan for delays and add extra time to their commutes.

Bettis Asphalt & Construction, of Topeka, is the contractor on the \$128,000 project.
