
U.S. 24/Meriden Road intersection closure planned in Topeka

The Kansas Department of Transportation plans to close the U.S. 24/Meriden Road intersection and a small portion of Meriden Road north of U.S. 24 in Topeka for paving work on Wednesday, Nov. 29, weather permitting.

The closure is part of the ongoing U.S. 24 reconstruction project and is expected to be in place for about 2 weeks, conditions permitting, while the frontage road intersection is paved.

Traffic can follow the marked detour on N.E. 35th Street and Kansas Avenue or use alternative routes.
