U.S. 40 closure delayed on Lawrence DDI project

The Kansas Department of Transportation has delayed the temporary closure of U.S. 40 in Lawrence due to unexpected utility relocation setbacks on the U.S. 40/K-10 diverging diamond interchange (DDI) project. The closure was scheduled to occur this summer but will now be postponed until next spring, conditions permitting.

The project will remain an active work zone as work continues in areas not effected by the utility setbacks. Traffic impacts should be minimal through the end of this construction season.

The full interchange closure is still expected to occur in summer 2024. Updates will be provided prior to work starting.
