SPECIAL PROVISION TO THE
STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS, EDITION 2007**

Add the following SECTION in DIVISION 800:

RAILROAD SIGNING AND PROTECTIVE LIABILITY INSURANCE

1.0 DESCRIPTION

Install the reflectorized advance-warning and railroad crossing signs as shown in the Contract Documents. Provide the railroad protective liability insurance policy as specified in SECTION 107.

2.0 MATERIALS

Provide materials that comply with the applicable requirements.

Post.....	DIVISION 2300
Preservative Treatment for Timber	DIVISION 2300
Metal Sheets	DIVISION 1600
Reflective Sheeting	DIVISION 2200
Center Mount Reflectors	DIVISION 2200

3.0 CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS

a. Railroad Signing. Fabricate, process and assemble signs as shown in the Contract Documents.

Set posts to the required depth. Plumb and set the post so the face of the sign when attached to the post faces slightly away from the road at an angle approximately 93° to the centerline of the highway. Firmly backfill the posts in place.

Install advance warning signs and railroad crossing signs as shown in the Contract Documents or as directed by the Engineer.

4.0 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

The Engineer will measure each reflectorized advance-warning and railroad crossing sign.

The Engineer will measure railroad protective liability insurance by the lump sum.

Payment for "Reflectorized Advance-Warning Signs", "Reflectorized Railroad Crossing Signs" and "Railroad Protective Liability Insurance" at the contract unit price is full compensation for the specified work.
