
Recreational Trails



RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM

The Federal Recreational Trails Program (RTP) was established to provide funds to States for the development and maintenance of recreational trails and trail-related facilities for both motorized and non-motorized trail types. RTP is a part of the Federal Highway Transportation Fund and is funded by the portion of the motor fuels excise tax collected from non-highway recreational fuel use. Examples of sources for the funds are taxes collected from fuel used for off-highway motorcycles, all-terrain vehicles, snowmobiles and other vehicles used for recreation.

As with other transportation funding, RTP funds are distributed based upon formula as legislated in the Federal Transportation Program. Under SAFE-TEA-LU and the extensions that have followed, half of the RT funds allocated are distributed equally among the States and half are distributed based on the pro rata of recreational fuel used in the State to the total recreational fuel used by all States.

Each state administers its own program and in Kansas at the authority of the Governor, this authority is given to the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism (KDWP&T). Since RTP projects are not under the administration of KDOT, the RTP projects are

not included in Appendixes A-D of this document. Instead, RTP projects and associated funding anticipated in the Federal Fiscal Years 2013-2016 STIP are listed on the following page. The funding estimated for each of these projects is based upon the funding provided to RTP under SAFETEA-LU and subsequent extensions with a small inflation factor. As the funding information supplied for the projects is only an estimate, the information is subject to change based upon whatever may be approved in the new Federal Transportation Program when passed.
