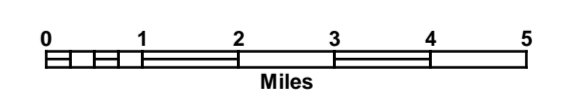

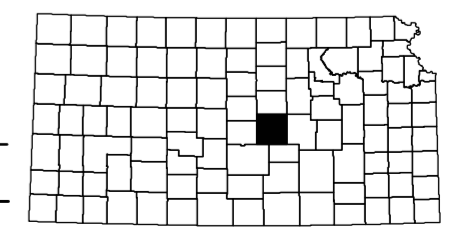


GENERAL HIGHWAY MAP
