Crack seal work on K-179 south of Anthony to start

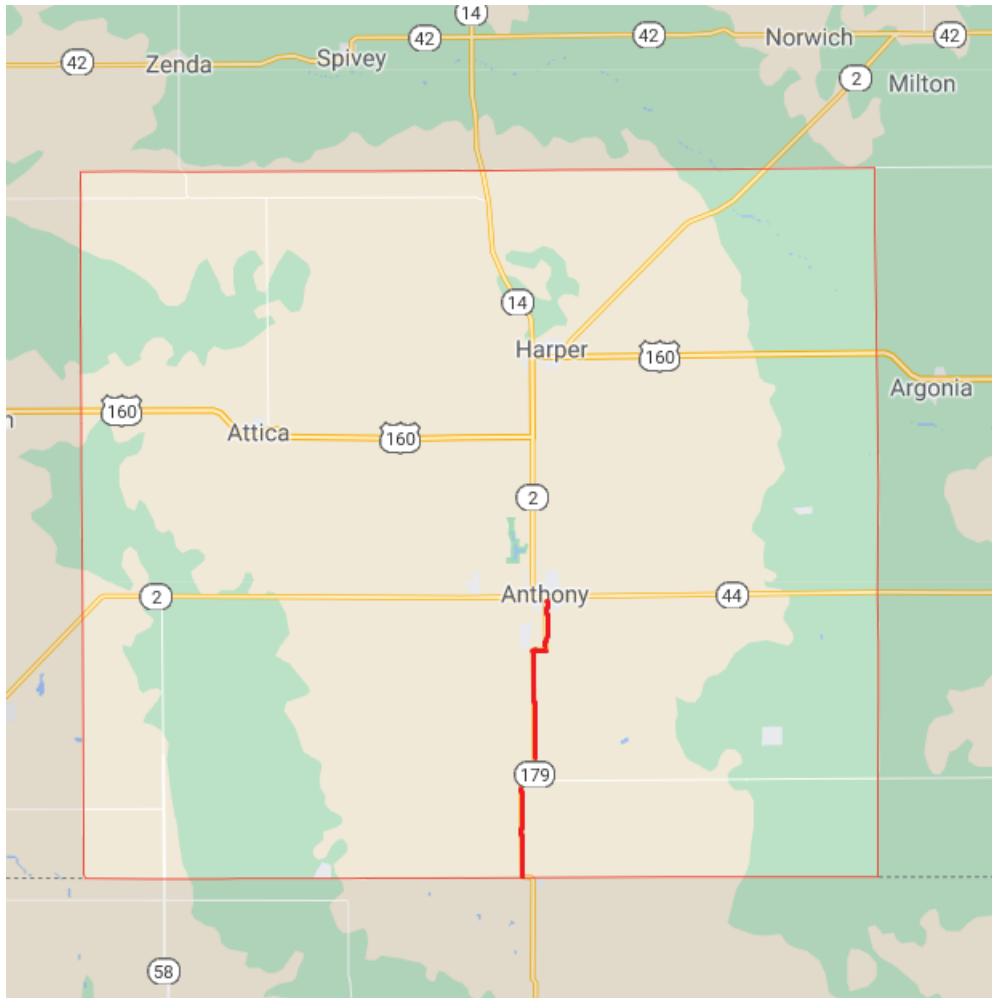
An asphalt crack seal project will begin soon on K-179 south of Anthony, in Harper County.

The work will be on K-179 from the Oklahoma state line north to the south city limits of Anthony. The length is a little over 11 miles.

During the project – beginning around March 1 and ending around March 29 – traffic will be controlled by flaggers and a pilot car. Motorists should be prepared to slow down and stop for the work zone.

Pavement Pros, of McPherson, is the prime contractor for the \$47,422 project, overseen by the Kansas Department of Transportation.
