K-11 bridge project in Reno County to start soon

Replacement of a K-11 bridge in Reno County is expected to begin around March 8.

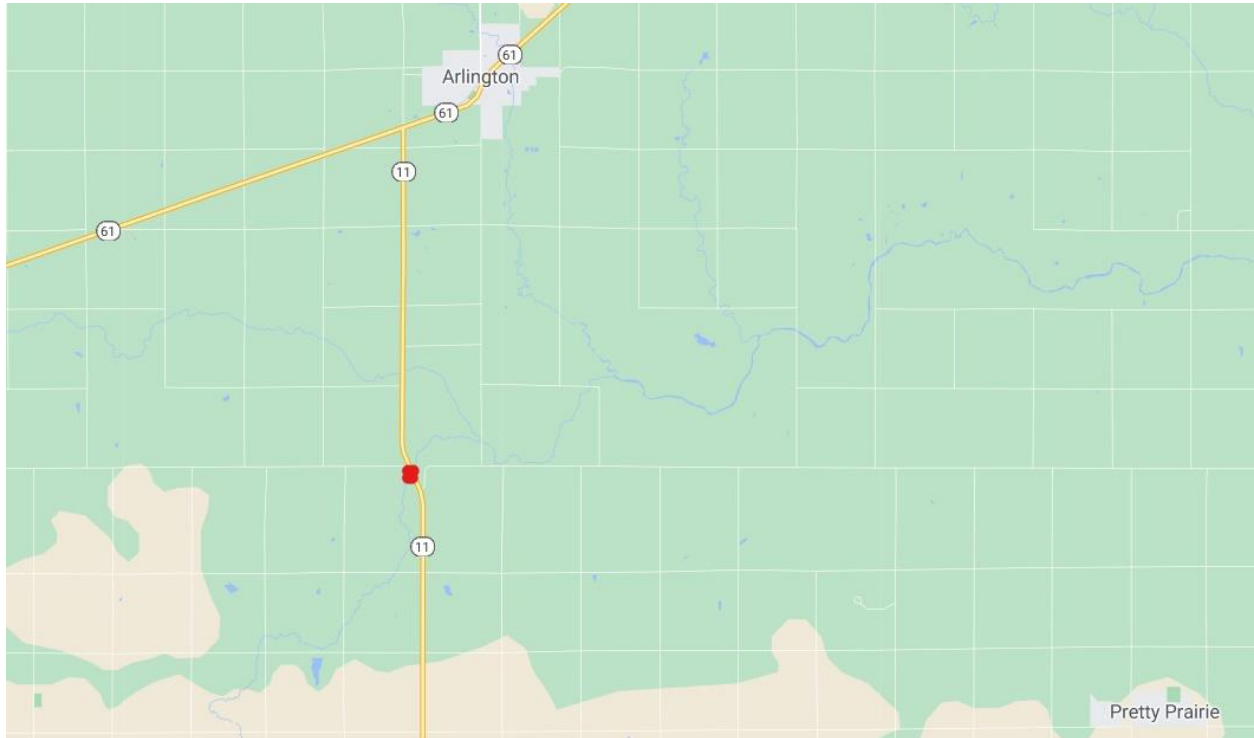
The project is on K-11 at Goose Creek, 6.32 miles north of the Reno/Kingman County line.

During the project, traffic will be diverted to a temporary road at the construction site. Motorists should be prepared to slow down through the construction zone.

Depending on the weather, the project is expected to be completed around mid-December.

King Construction Co. Inc., of Hesston, is the prime contractor for the \$1,460,469 project.
