K-2 bridge field survey to start in Harper County

A field survey for a proposed bridge replacement on K-2 in Harper County is scheduled to begin around Tuesday, July 6.

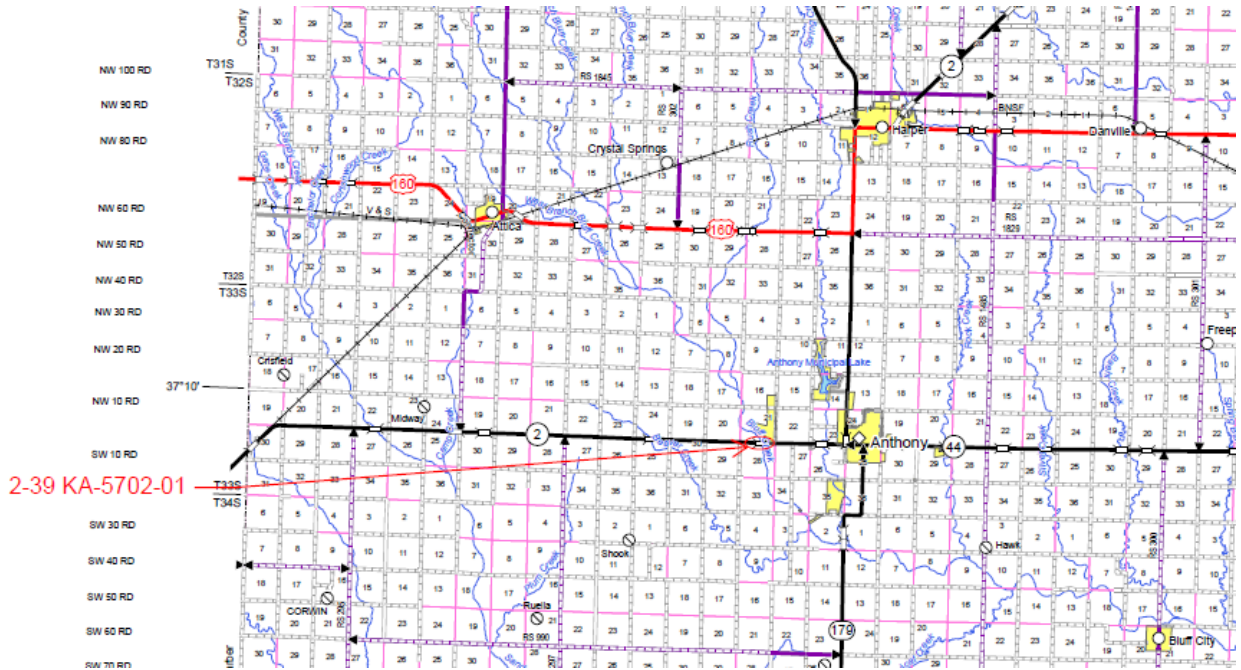
The survey will be for bridge replacement over Bluff Creek, about 2.5 miles west of the K-44/K-2 junction in Anthony. The approximate length of the survey is 2,500 feet. The survey will be based on existing alignment.

The field survey – estimated to be completed by Aug. 13 -- will gather information needed for detailed design of the proposed improvement.

A member of the survey crew first will contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.

Doug Roeder, P.S., Survey Project Manager, Wilson & Co., will be in charge of this survey for the Kansas Department of Transportation.
