Resurfacing project to begin Tuesday on K-181

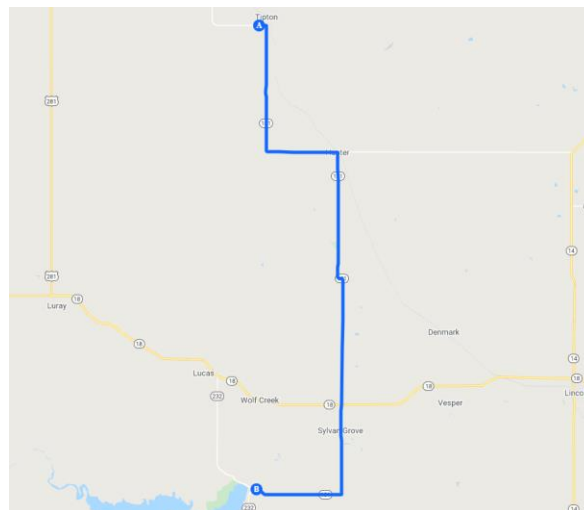
Starting Tuesday, Oct. 12, the Kansas Department of Transportation will begin an overlay on K-181 in Russell, Lincoln, and Mitchell counties.

Work on K-181 will extend from the junction of K-232/K-181 to the Mitchell/Osborne county line. (See attached map.)

Traffic will be reduced to one lane controlled by flaggers and a pilot car. Drivers should be prepared for a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

APAC-Kansas Inc. of Hutchinson is the prime contractor and has scheduled this \$6 million project to be completed by January 2022, weather permitting.
