KDOT maintenance projects affecting traffic

- The On Ramp from Main St. to WB US 54 will be closed Monday the 4th from 10 am until 4 pm for pavement repair. NEW
- The left lane of WB US 54, Sycamore to Meridian, will be closed Monday the
 4th from 10 am until 4 pm for pavement repair. NEW
- The left lane of K-254 near Oliver will be closed Monday the 4th, 10 am 4
 pm, for guardrail repairs. NEW
- Pothole patching will continue this week. More stable patching will be possible later in the spring.

KDOT construction projects affecting traffic

1. Gold Project Phase 2A: North Junction – I-135, I-235, K-96 & K-254

Construction began on April 5, 2021. Three-year project that replaces the I-135 ramps to SB I-235/WB K-96. Project website at <u>www.135gold.org</u>.

- A long-term 11' width restriction on the two lanes of SB I-135, 53rd St. to south of the I-235/K-254, is in effect (along with a 50-mph work zone speed limit).
- 2. WICHway Camera & Message Board installations (15 locations)

Phase 5 of WICHway installations began on March 22, 2021. Some work will require lane or shoulder closures but most of the work will have little impact to traffic.

3. Guardrail repair or replacement on K-96, east of I-135

Installation of new or repair of old guardrail on K-96 from I-135 to east of Webb Road **began Jan. 31.** Expect some daytime right lane closures occasionally when barrier wall is installed at five of the 26 locations. Most of the work will be adjacent to the highway and will not affect normal traffic flow.

4. Pavement patching on K-96, east of Webb Road to U.S. 54

Repairs to driving surface and ramps of K-96 from east of Webb Road to U.S. 54. This **night work project** is scheduled for **Sunday – Friday nights, 7 pm – 6 am although earlier start times are expected on Sundays**. *Work began on the EB K-96 on March 13*. Traffic control (lane and ramp closures) will be removed each day by 6 am. A one-week closure of the EB US 54 exit to WB K-96 will occur but the date has not been set. This project may require daily updates.

- This week, work will continue on the **right lane of WB K-96, 21**st **St. to Greenwich, plus the 21**st **St. On Ramp and Greenwich Exit may be closed overnight** (open by 6 am usually). If good progress is made, the Greenwich

 On Ramp to WB K-96 may be closed late in the week. **Continuing**
- Possible work may occur on EB K-96 from Greenwich to 21st St. Continuing
- 5. Construction of a new **roundabout at 61st North and N. Broadway** has begun. This is ½ mile west of I-135 in Park City. Completion expected in late 2022.
- 6. Resurfacing (asphalt overlay and shoulder widening) on K-96 from the Reno/Sedgwick county line to Maize Road is scheduled to begin April 4 with a completion date in May. Traffic will be reduced to one lane for EB K-96. NEW PROJECT
- **7**. Pavement marking at the **U.S. 54 and Andover Road intersection** began Sunday, March 27. The work will be in the evening and overnight hours, **7 pm 6 am**. An 11' width restriction will be in place during working hours.
 - Work will continue this week 7 pm 6 am, weather permitting.
