Field survey set for U.S. 56 guardrail improvements west of Lyons

The Kansas Department of Transportation will do a field survey for proposed guardrail improvements along U.S. 56 west of Lyons.

The field survey will be for two locations: .25 mile east of 10th Road and .14 mile east of 11th Road. The survey will begin around Monday, Feb. 7, and is expected to be completed by Feb. 18. The approximate length of the survey is 800 feet, and it will be based on the existing alignment.

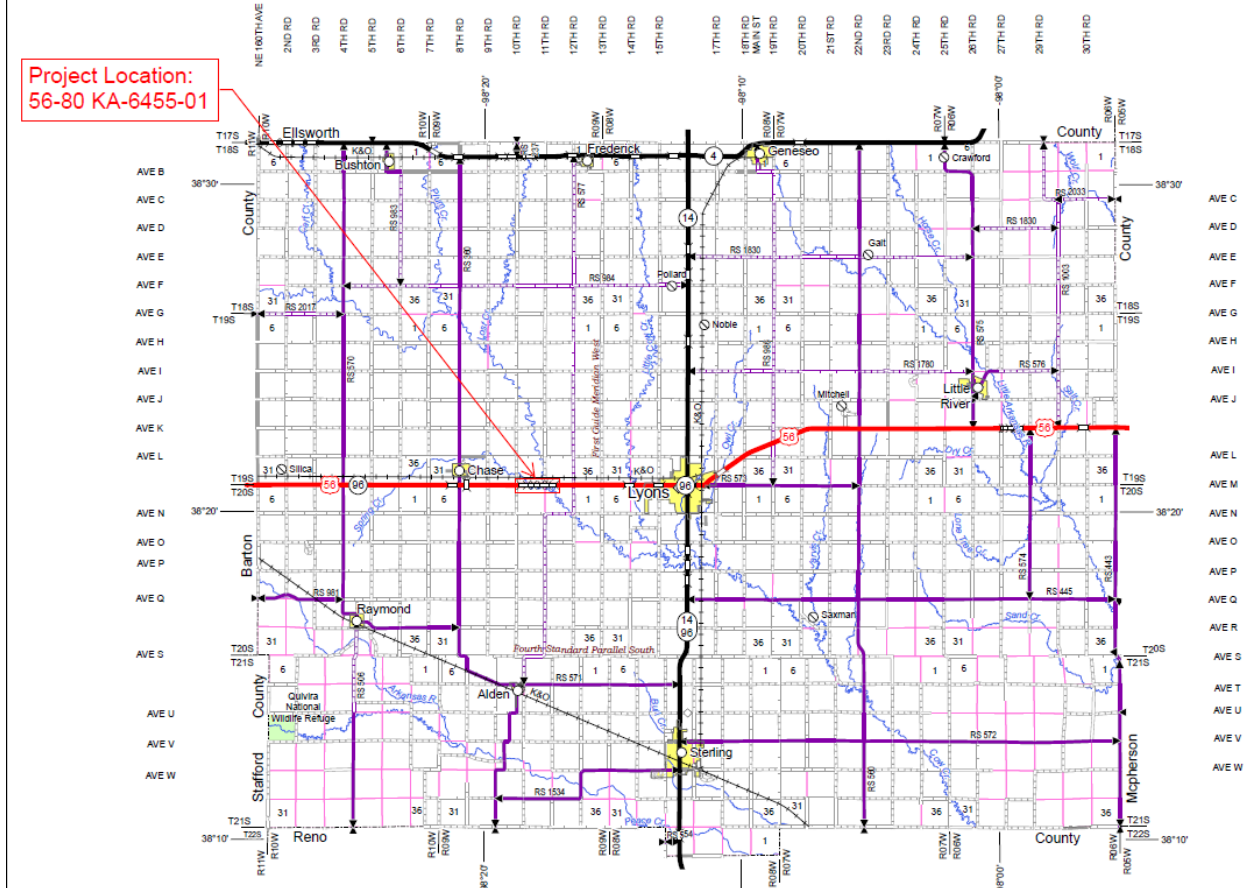
The field survey will gather information needed for detailed design of the proposed improvements.

A member of the survey crew first will contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property if needed. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.

Kara LaRiviere, P.S., Survey Project Manager, Bureau of Right of Way, will be in charge of the survey for KDOT.
