KDOT construction projects affecting traffic

1. Gold Project Phase 2A: North Junction – I-135, I-235, K-96 & K-254

Construction began on April 5, 2021. Three-year project that replaces the I-135 ramps to SB I-235/WB K-96. Project website at <u>www.135gold.org</u>.

• A long-term **11' width restriction on the two lanes of SB I-135, 53**rd **St. to south of the I-235/K-254**, is in effect (along with a **50 mph work zone speed** *limit*).

2. WICHway Camera & Message Board installations (15 locations)

Phase 5 of WICHway installations began on March 22, 2021. Some work will require lane or shoulder closures but most of the work will have little impact to traffic.

3. Right turn lane improvement on Patriot Ave. to K-15 in Derby

Installation of a right turn lane from W. Patriot Ave. to K-15 in NW Derby began on June 21. Some lane closures will be necessary. The project **should finish soon**.

• Work continues on traffic signal controllers to adjust/improve signal timing.
