KDOT construction projects affecting traffic

1. Gold Project Phase 2A: North Junction — I-135, I-235, K-96 & K-254

Construction began on April 5, 2021. Three-year project that replaces the I-135 ramps to SB I-235/WB K-96. Project website at www.135gold.org.

 A long-term 11' width restriction on the two lanes of SB I-135, 53rd St. to south of the I-235/K-254, is in effect (along with a 50 mph work zone speed limit).

2. WICHway Camera & Message Board installations (15 locations)

Phase 5 of WICHway installations began on March 22, 2021. Some work will require lane or shoulder closures but most of the work will have little impact to traffic.

3. Guardrail repair or replacement on K-96, east of I-135

Installation of new or repair of old guardrail on K-96 from I-135 to east of Webb Road **began Jan. 31.** Expect some daytime right lane closures occasionally when barrier wall is installed at five of the 26 locations. Most of the work will be adjacent to the highway and will not affect normal traffic flow.

- Currently working on EB K-96 at Rock Road plus other eastbound locations.
- 4. Pavement patching on K-96, east of Webb Road to U.S. 54 NEW PROJECT

Repairs to driving surface and ramps of K-96 from east of Webb Road to U.S. 54. This **night work project** is scheduled for **Sunday – Thursday nights, 7 pm – 6 am although earlier start times are expected on Sundays**. Traffic control (lane and ramp closures) will be removed each day by 6 am. A one-week closure of the EB US 54 exit to WB K-96 will occur but the date has not been set.

- Work is expected to begin on EB K-96 at noon Sunday, March 13. NEW
- The Greenwich Exit and On Ramp are scheduled to be closed Sunday afternoon until no later than 6 am Monday. NEW
- On Monday night, the 21st St. Exit and On Ramp are scheduled to be closed until no later than 6 am Tuesday. NEW
- 5. Construction of a new roundabout at 61st North and N. Broadway is scheduled to begin Monday, March 14. This is ½ mile west of I-135 in Park City. NEW PROJECT
