## I-435 & Quivira Road Interchange

Beginning at **9:00 a.m. on Monday, April 9**, the Quivira Road to westbound I-435 Street exit ramp will **CLOSE** for approximately 150 days to complete reconstruction work at the interchange. This ramp reconstruction work is part of the I-435 & US-69 "Red" Improvement Project which began construction in late summer 2011.

Advance message boards will alert drivers to the ramp closure. A marked detour will be provided. Quivira Road traffic will detour southbound on Quivira Road to eastbound College Boulevard to northbound US-69 back to westbound I-435. Ramp-related project work is scheduled to be completed and the ramp reopened to all traffic **in early September 2012**, weather permitting.
