I-70 at 18th Street Ramp Closure

EXPECT DELAYS! The <u>westbound I-70 to northbound 18th Street ramp</u> will be closed to all traffic beginning at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 27 for emergency repair work on drainage structures underneath the ramp.

Advance message boards will alert drivers to the ramp closure. A marked detour will be provided. Traffic will take westbound I-70 to 38th Street/Park Drive, and then take Park Drive back to 18th Street. Drivers should expect minor delays and must use alternate routes during the ramp closure.
