

Flooded Road Closures for NORTHEAST KANSAS

As of Thursday, August 11, 11:30 a.m.

<u>K-7 in Doniphan County</u> is STILL CLOSED from Iowa Point to the Nebraska/Kansas state line due to high waters from the Missouri River on the roadway. As of Thursday, August 4, a portion of the previously flooded K-7 has been reopened from the City of Sparks to Iowa Point. K-7 originally closed to all traffic on Tuesday, May 31, 2011 at 8:15 a.m.

<u>K-5 in Leavenworth County</u> is NOW OPEN from Eisenhower Road to Mary Street in the City of Lansing. K-5 was closed to all through traffic on Saturday, July 2, 2011 at approximately 6:00 a.m. due to high waters from the Missouri River on the roadway.

<u>US-59 in Atchison County (Kansas</u>) is STILL CLOSED over the Amelia Earhart Bridge to the junction of US-45 in Buchanan County, Missouri due to flooding on the Missouri side of US-59, as of 9:45 p.m. on Monday, June 27. The only other river crossings available until further notice are at US-36 in St. Joseph, MO, and the Centennial Bridge/K-92 in Leavenworth, KS.

Drivers must use alternate routes. No marked detours provided. Drivers: Do not attempt to drive through flooded or high water on roadways. TURN AROUND. DON'T DROWN!

We will let you know when these roadways reopen to all traffic.
