

Flooded Road Closures for NORTHEAST KANSAS As of Wednesday, June 22, 2011, 8:30 a.m.

K-7 in Doniphan County is STILL CLOSED and is now closed further south from Iowa Point at the city of White Cloud to the Nebraska/Kansas state line due to high waters from the Missouri River on the roadway. The roadway is expected to be closed for several more days due to continued melting snow from the northern states that are contributing to high river levels. This portion of K-7 closed to all traffic on Tuesday, May 31, 2011 at 8:15 a.m.

Drivers must use alternate routes. No marked detours provided. Drivers: Do not attempt to drive through flooded or high water on roadways. TURN AROUND. DON'T DROWN!

We will let you know when the roadway reopens to all traffic.
