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K-92 Centennial Bridge

For Friday/Monday, August 31-October 15, 2012 in Leavenworth (Leavenworth County)

On **Friday, August 31 by approximately 3:00 p.m.,** all traffic control, including traffic signals, will be removed from the K-92 Centennial Bridge and the bridge will be open to unrestricted traffic. Then beginning on **Tuesday, September 4 through Monday, October 15**, traffic over the K-92 Centennial bridge will be reduced to one lane for street lighting and expansion joint repair work. Traffic will be directed over the bridge through the project work zone via a flagging operation. Work will take place Monday through Saturday, with the majority of work taking place during non-peak morning and evening commute timeframes.

<u>Note:</u> The K-92 Centennial Bridge is still scheduled to be closed to all traffic for two consecutive weekend long closures as noted below.

The K-92 Centennial Bridge project is scheduled to be completed in its entirety and opened to all unrestricted traffic on **Monday, October 15, weather permitting.** (KDOT Project #92-52 KA-1507-01)

For Friday/Monday, September 14-17 & September 21-24 2012 in Leavenworth (Leavenworth County)

EXPECT DELAYS! Eastbound and westbound K-92 lanes over the Centennial Bridge in Leavenworth will be CLOSED to all traffic on both the Kansas and Missouri sides of the state line for bridge repair work beginning at 7:00 p.m. on Friday, September 14 and will reopen to unrestricted traffic at 5:00 a.m. on

Monday, September 17 and then again at 7:00 p.m. on Friday, September 21 and will reopen to unrestricted traffic at 5:00 a.m. on Monday, September 24. (In the case of inclement weather either weekend, the full bridge closure will be rescheduled for the following weekend.) This full closure of the bridge is needed for the jacking of the bridge to replace some structural members under the bridge.

Advance message boards will alert traffic to the full bridge closure. A marked detour will be provided during the weekend closures. Traffic will detour via US-73/K-7 north to US-59 in Atchison then east on US-59 into Missouri to Missouri Route 45 south to Missouri Route 92 and vice versa for traffic on the Missouri side of the bridge closure. Project work for the two weekend-long closures is scheduled to be completed on **Monday, September 24, weather permitting.** (KDOT Project #92-52 KA-1507-01)

The Kansas Department of Transportation urges all motorists to be alert, obey the warning signs, and "Give 'Em a Brake!" when approaching and driving through the project work zone.
