EXPECT DELAYS! LANE CLOSURES: Eastbound and westbound U.S. 56 over the New Century Road and Industrial Parkway Bridges will be reduced to one lane in each direction, 24/7 round the clock, for polymer overlay work beginning on Monday, April 7 at 9:00 a.m. Crews will work during the day on Monday to set traffic control and the lanes will be fully closed once traffic control is in place.

Traffic will be directed through the project work zone via signage and cones. There will be a 12-foot lane width restriction through the project work zone during the duration of the project.
