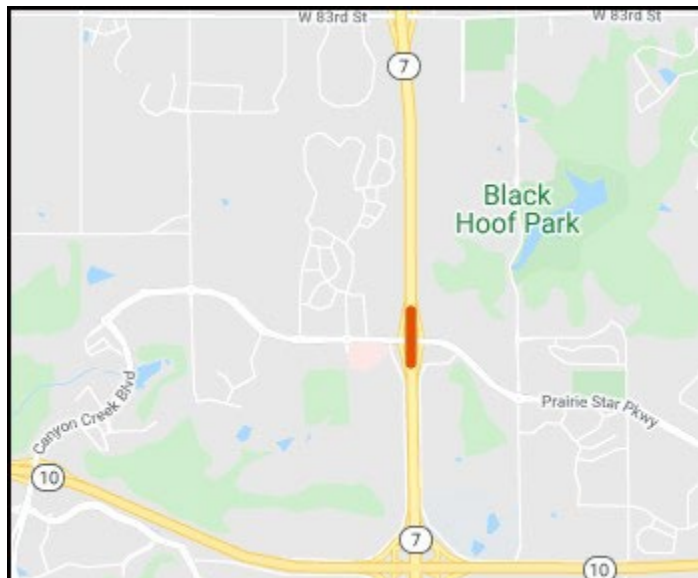

**Bridge girder repair at 95th Street/Prairie Star Parkway
over K-7 in Johnson County to begin April 19**

A bridge girder repair project at 95th Street/Prairie Star Parkway over K-7 in Lenexa is expected to begin Monday, April 19, weather permitting, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation. The project includes repair of prestressed concrete bridge girders. The expected completion of the project is mid-May.

Work will occur 6 a. m. to 4 p.m., Monday to Thursday. Northbound K-7 will be reduced to one lane at 95th Street/Prairie Star Parkway overpass, for two weeks while the work is being done to the bridge.

Southbound K-7 will be reduced to one lane at 95th Street/Prairie Star Parkway overpass from May 3 to May 13 between 6 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday to Thursday. During the same time, the north lane on 95th St./Prairie Star Parkway Bridge will be closed. Both eastbound and westbound traffic will continue with no exclusive turning lanes.



Traffic will be controlled using signage, arrow boards, barricades and traffic cones. Senne & Company, of Topeka, is the contractor on the \$115,057 project.
