## **I-35 pavement project in Johnson and Wyandotte counties to begin July 19**

A pavement marking repair project on I-35 from 95<sup>th</sup> Street to the Missouri state line (approximately 11 miles) is scheduled to begin Monday, July 19, weather permitting.

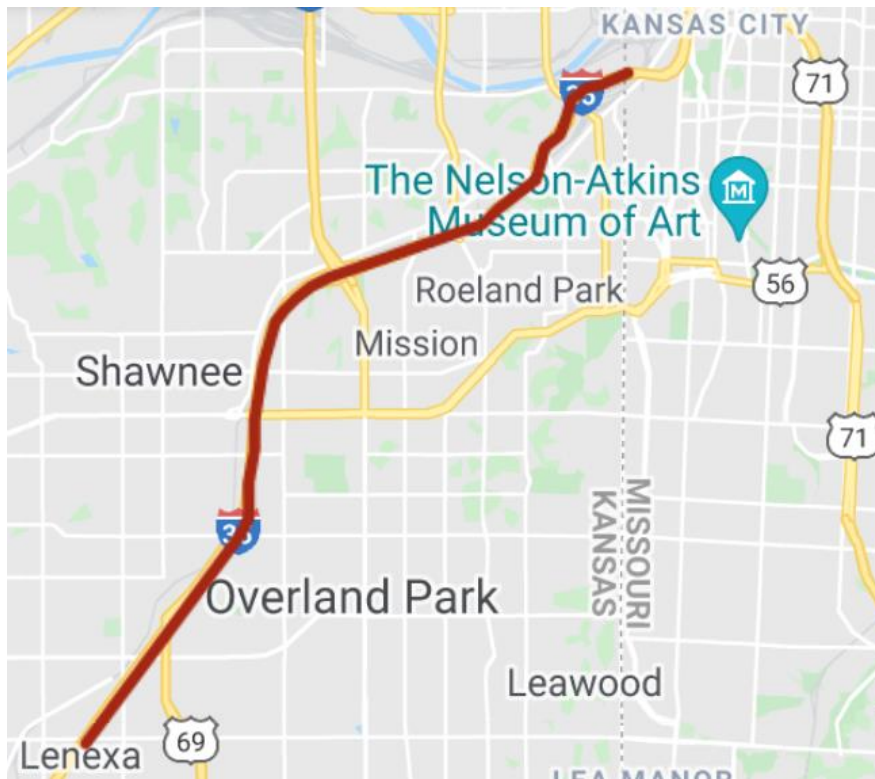
According to the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT), this northbound and southbound I-35 will have nightly lane and ramp closures in areas where work is occurring. Message boards alerting motorists are in place, notifying the start of the project.

Work will occur 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday through Friday. The project is anticipated to be completed in late August.

Twin Traffic, of Kansas City, Mo., is the contractor for the \$1.2 million project.
