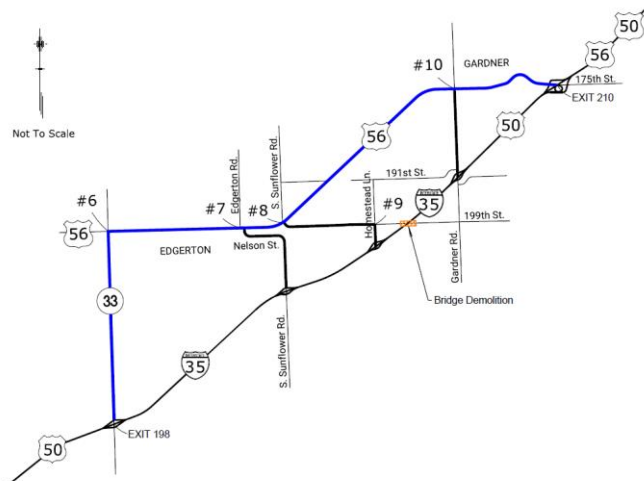

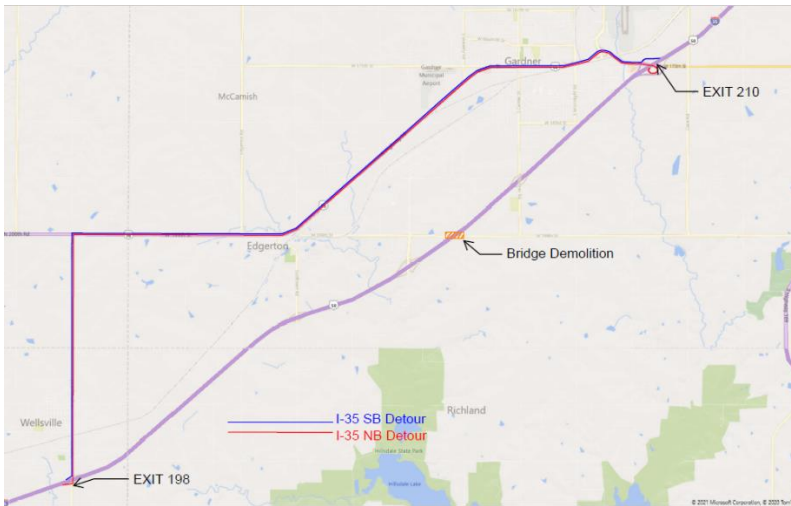
KDOT construction projects affecting traffic:

- 1. Bridge demolition of the existing 199<sup>th</sup> St. bridge over I-35 – NEW**  
**Northbound and southbound I-35 will be shut down and traffic detoured from 5 a.m. Sat. Jan. 30 to 5 a.m. Sun. Jan. 31.**

➤ Detour route:

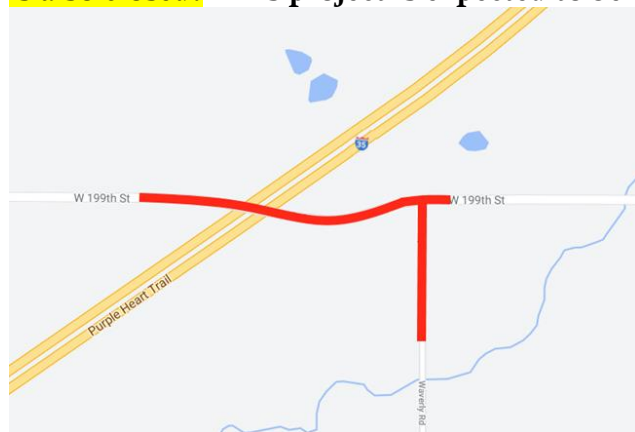
- Southbound I-35 onto Exit 210/U.S. 56, then back to I-35 at Wellsville.
- Northbound I-35 onto Exit 198/K-33, then to U.S. 56 back to I-35 at Gardner.

**2. 199th St and Waverly Road - (ONGOING)**

The 199th Street overpass over I-35 between Homestead Lane and Gardner Road is closed for the replacement of the overpass bridge. Waverly Road access to 199th Street from 207th Street is also closed. This project is expected to be completed by October 2021.

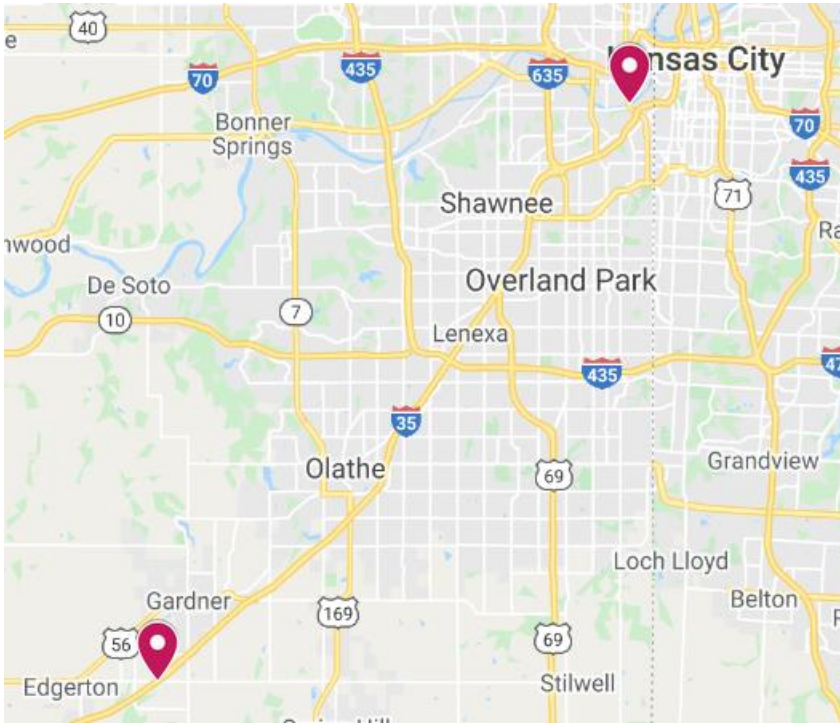
