Lane closures on southbound I-35 in Johnson County Friday night

According to the Kansas Department of Transportation, lane closures will occur on southbound I-35 at 199th Street, between mile marker 205 and mile marker 207, from 10 p.m. Friday, April 2 to 8 a.m. Saturday, April 3, weather permitting.

At 8 p.m. on Friday April 2, the left lane of northbound and southbound I-35 will be closed. Work will include girder erections over southbound I-35 at 199th Street and multiple complete lane closures are expected throughout the night and may last up to 15 minutes each. Traffic will be controlled using a pilot car operation. Signage and traffic cones will also be used.

Drivers should expect delays and are encouraged to find alternative routes.
