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Pavement repair project at U.S. 56/I-35 ramps to begin May 8

According to the Kansas Department of Transportation, a pavement repair project on U.S. 56 to the I-35 ramps is expected to begin Saturday, May 8, and conclude May 16, weather permitting.

The project, east of Moonlight Road in the City of Gardner, Johnson County, includes concrete pavement patching and asphalt overlay. The expected completion of the project is mid-July.

Work will take place during the following times:

Saturday, 7 p.m. to Monday, 6 a.m.;
Wednesday, 7 p.m. to Thursday, 6 a.m.; and
Thursday, 7 p.m. to Friday, 6 a.m.

Eastbound and westbound U.S. 56 will be reduced to one lane during hours of work. All lanes of traffic will be open when work is not being performed.

Traffic will be controlled using signage, arrow boards, barricades and traffic cones. Superior Bowen, of Olathe, is the contractor for the \$1,288,763.57 project.
