Survey for proposed I-635 bridge replacement to begin May 17

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) to begin a field survey, Monday, May 17, for a proposed bridge replacement on I-635 in Wyandotte County.

The proposed bridge replacement is located over Metropolitan Avenue, about 1 mile south of old K-132.

The survey is to gather information that is necessary for the detailed design of the proposed improvement and is estimated to be completed by July 1, 2021.

John Sommers, P.S., Survey Project Manager, JEO, will be in charge of this survey for KDOT.

A member of the survey crew first will contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.
