### **U.S. 69 bridge maintenance project at 191<sup>st</sup> Street and 179<sup>th</sup> Street bridges to begin June 14 in Overland Park**

According to the Kansas Department of Transportation, a bridge maintenance project on U.S. 69, at the 191<sup>st</sup> Street and 179<sup>th</sup> Street bridges, is expected to begin June 14, weather permitting.

For the duration of the project, northbound U.S. 69 will be reduced to one lane from 191<sup>st</sup> Street to 179<sup>th</sup> Street.

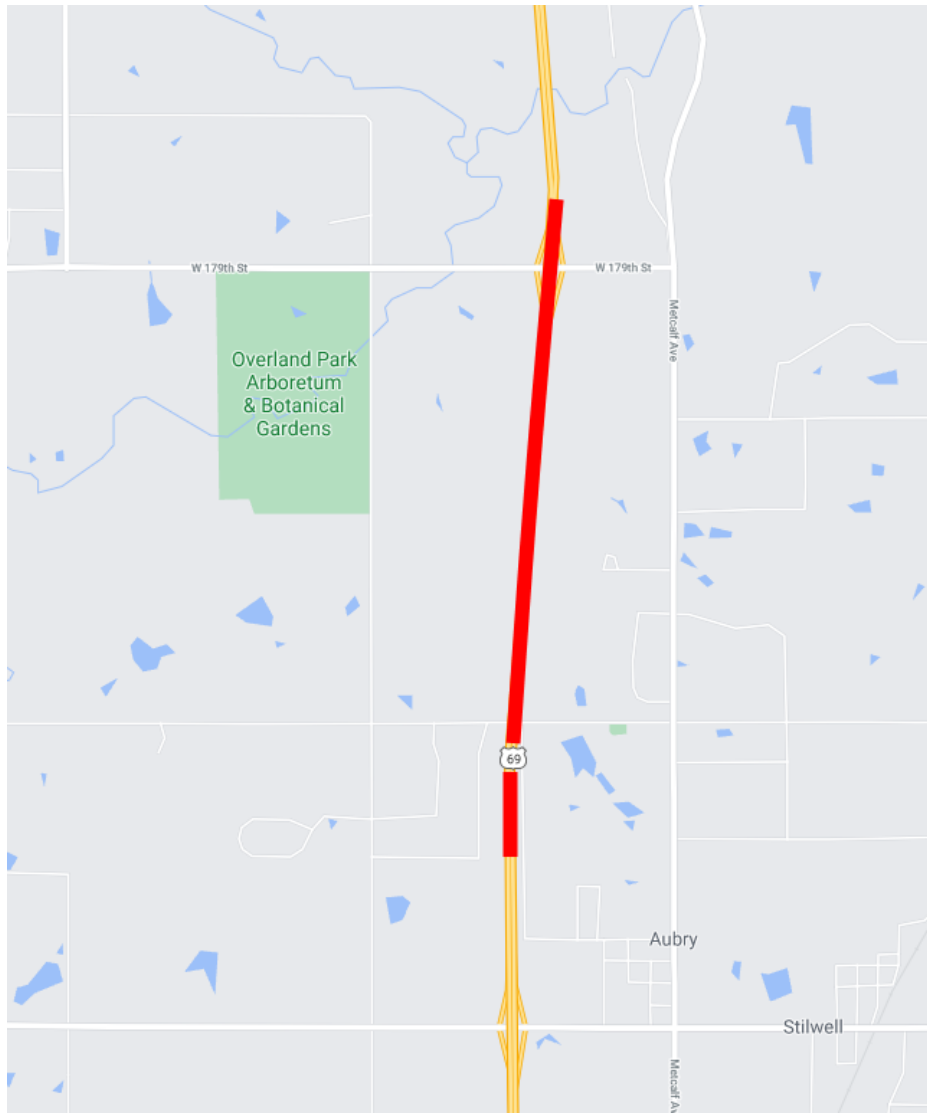
Maintenance will include concrete pavement patching and bridge overlay application. Work will occur Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., and Saturday as needed. The project is expected to be completed in mid-November.

Traffic will be controlled using lane and ramp closures, portable message signs, arrow boards, signage, and traffic cones.

PCI Roads, of St. Michael, MN, is the contractor on the \$846,863.77 project.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone.
