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## **Pavement project begins tonight on I-635 in Wyandotte County**

A Kansas Department of Transportation pavement improvement project on northbound and southbound I-635, from K-32 to Victory Drive, in Kansas City, is scheduled to begin tonight, Tuesday, April 9, weather permitting.

This project includes road and bridge patching, asphalt overlay and pavement marking of all I-635 lanes and adjacent ramps.

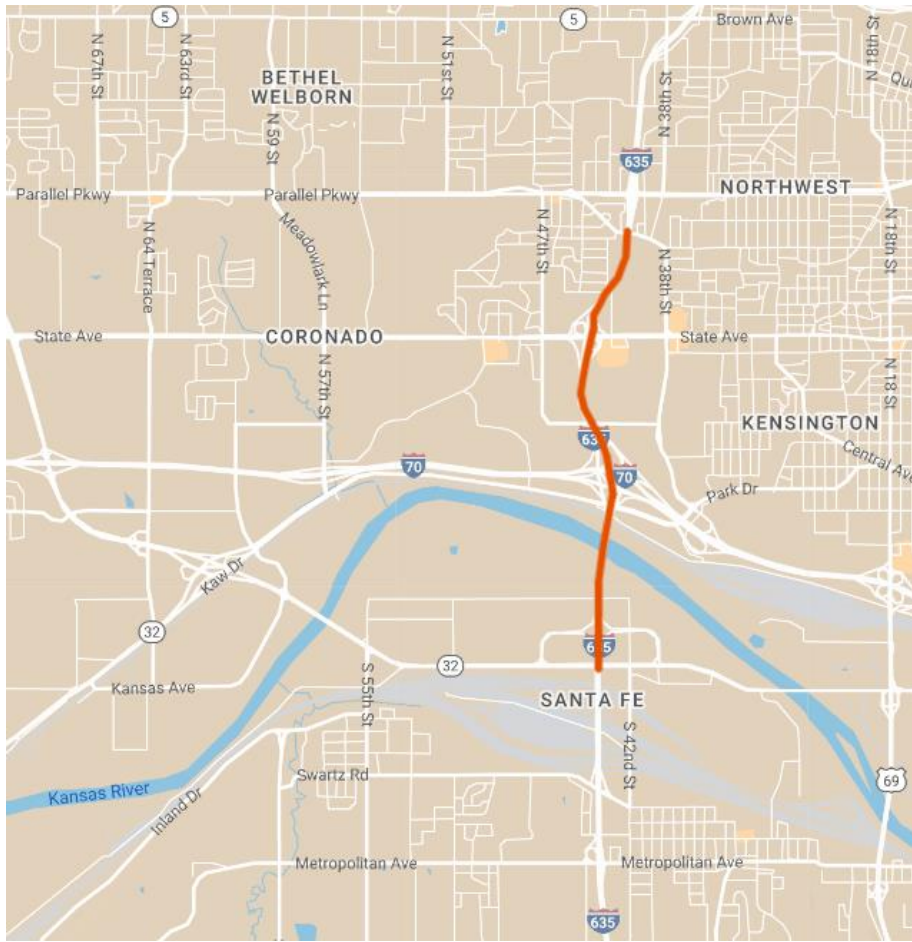
For the duration of the project, nightly lane and ramp closures will be scheduled with limited daytime work. No more than two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time in the project work zone.

Message boards have been posted in the area to alert motorists of upcoming work. Traffic will be controlled using lane and ramp closures, portable message boards, signage, barricades and traffic cones.

Ideker, Inc., of St. Joseph, Mo. is the contractor for the \$12.9 million project, which is expected to be completed in early September.
