Southbound U.S. 69 segment will be fully closed tonight and Saturday night in Overland Park

All southbound U.S. 69 lanes, from 119th Street to Blue Valley Parkway, and the 119th Street to southbound U.S. 69 entrance ramp, in Overland Park will be **fully closed** to traffic overnight during the following times:

- 7 p.m., Friday, Feb. 23 to 10 a.m., Saturday Feb. 24 and
- 6 p.m., Saturday, Feb. 24 to 10 a.m., Sunday, Feb. 25.

These temporary closures are necessary for bridge work on the new Blue Valley Parkway to southbound U.S. 69 flyover entrance ramp and are part of the Kansas Department of Transportation U.S. 69 Expansion Project (69Express). All scheduled project work is weather permitting and subject to change.


During these temporary closures, detours will be marked as follows:

- Southbound U.S. 69: traffic will be directed to exit at 119th Street and turn left, then travel east to Blue Valley Parkway and turn right to travel south and use the Blue Valley Parkway to southbound U.S. 69 entrance ramp.
- 119th Street to enter southbound U.S. 69: traffic will be directed to turn south onto Switzer Road, then turn left onto 135th Street and travel west to use the 135th Street to southbound U.S. 69 entrance ramp.

The 69Express project includes reconstruction of U.S. 69, widening the highway with added express lanes – one in each direction between 151st and 103rd Streets – and interchange improvements at U.S. 69/167th Street in Overland Park.
