These informational open houses will each feature the same meeting materials at both dates and locations. Attendees will have the opportunity to review updates on the K-10 Corridor Project, review the proposed project improvements, provide input and speak one-on-one with project staff. There will be no formal presentations, and attendees are welcome to come and go at any time during the meetings.

Currently in the Environmental Assessment (EA) phase required by the National Environmental Protection Act (NEPA), the K-10 Corridor Project is evaluating alternative solutions to improve safety, relieve congestion and support economic development on the K-10 corridor.

The K-10 corridor is a 16.5-mile stretch of state highway from the Douglas/Johnson County Line to I-435 in Johnson County, Kansas. Spanning De Soto, Lenexa and Olathe, the corridor supports existing and future development in eastern Kansas and the Kansas City metropolitan area.

Following the open houses, the information presented will also be available online at <u>www.k10.ksdot.gov</u> with the opportunity for online public comment from April 19 to May 19, 2024. Those interested will be able to sign up for project updates, review materials at their convenience and submit questions through an online form.

This project was moved to the KDOT Eisenhower Legacy Transportation Program (IKE) development pipeline in December 2021 with the construction letting date to be determined.
