## KDOT maintenance projects affecting traffic

- On Wednesday the 24<sup>th</sup>, from 9 am until 3 pm, the left lane of WB U.S. 54 from Oliver to Hillside, will be closed for maintenance in the median. *NEW*
- On Thursday the 25<sup>th</sup>, from 9 am until 3 pm, the left lane of WB U.S. 54 from Hillside to Washington, will be closed for maintenance in the median. NEW

## KDOT construction projects affecting traffic

## 1. Gold Project Phase 2A: North Junction – I-135, I-235, K-96 & K-254

Construction began on April 5, 2021. Three-year project that replaces the I-135 ramps to SB I-235/WB K-96. Project website at <u>www.135gold.org</u>.

- A new 11' width restriction has been posted on WB K-254 to SB I-235.
  NEW
- A long-term 11' width restriction on the two lanes of SB I-135, 53<sup>rd</sup> St. to south of the I-235/K-254, is in effect (along with a 50-mph work zone speed limit).
- 2. Pavement patching on K-96, east of Webb Road to U.S. 54

Repairs to driving surface and ramps of K-96 from east of Webb Road to U.S. 54. This **night work project** is scheduled for **Sunday – Friday nights, 7 pm – 6 am although earlier start times are expected on Sundays**. Traffic control (lane and ramp closures) will be removed each day by 6 am.

• Pavement patching continues on **WB K-96**. Expect single lane traffic, evening and overnight hours, Central to 21st.

3. Guardrail replacement on the NB I-235 Exit to NB I-135/EB K-254 and NB I-235 to SB I-135 began on April 30.

• **Barrier wall** and a **12' width limit** on the NB I-235 exit to NB I-135 and to EB K-254 is in place.

**4.** Highway striping on **U.S. 54**, **West St. to I-135**; **I-135**, **53**<sup>rd</sup> **St. N. to Harvey County**; **and U.S. 81**, **at South Junction ramps** began in June. This project will have day and night work plus ramps will be closed for restriping.

 Night work continues on NB & SB I-135 from 53<sup>rd</sup> St. N. to 77<sup>th</sup> St. N. Expect lane and possibly ramp closures between 7 pm and 6 am. Continuing

**5.** Repair of two bridges on **EB K-96 at Ridge Road** began May 2. Planned completion is in September. Expect single lane traffic for one mile west of Ridge Road.

- The right lane is closed near Ridge Road.
- A **12' width restriction** is in place.

6. Repair of the WB U.S. 54 bridge at the K-251 junction (far western Sedgwick County), began on May 2. Single lane traffic for each direction of U.S. 54 for one mile will be in place until completion (November). The 383<sup>rd</sup> St. On Ramp to WB U.S. 54 will be closed for the duration of the project (with a marked detour in place).

- Single lane traffic for each direction of U.S. 54, with crossovers, is now in place.
- The 383<sup>rd</sup> St. On Ramp to WB U.S. 54 is closed.

**7.** Construction of **right turn lanes on EB & WB K-254 at Rock Road** began May 9. *Completion should be in late September.* 

• No access to or from Rock Road at K-254 is allowed.

**8.** A **Field survey on U.S. 54 near I-235** for a proposed bridge replacement over the M.S. "Mitch" Mitchell Floodway **will begin Aug. 15**. Because of the high traffic numbers, survey work that restricts traffic or closes a lane is likely to take place in the evening or overnight hours.

9. Bridge Approach Leveling on I-135, K-15, K-96 & U.S. 54. NEW Project

Mudjacking (deep foam injection) will be used to level approaches at 23 bridges on Sedgwick County highways. **Work will begin Aug. 29**. Some bridges are outside of the Wichita metro and work will be completed during daylight hours. Most of the bridge locations are in high traffic locations and the work will occur Sunday – Thursday nights, 7 pm – 6 am.
