KDOT is hosting an open house-style public hearing about the East Kellogg/U.S. 54 Freeway project on Thursday, Nov. 17, from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. at the Sunflower Elementary School Gymnasium, 616 E. Douglas, Andover. Attendees will have an opportunity to review and comment on the EA document, view information on the environmental findings from the study and view updated designs for the Phase 1 and Phase 2 proposed improvements. KDOT Staff and project team will be present to answer questions. No formal presentation will be given at the meeting, and attendees are welcome to come and go at any time during the event between 5:00 and 7:00.

## KDOT construction projects affecting traffic

1. Gold Project Phase 2A: North Junction – I-135, I-235, K-96 & K-254

Construction began on April 5, 2021. Three-year project that replaces the I-135 ramps to SB I-235/WB K-96. Project website at <a href="https://www.135gold.org">www.135gold.org</a>.

- On Friday the 18th, the left lane of NB I-135 will be reduced to one lane from 37th St. to just south of 45th St., 9 am 3 pm, for left shoulder work. NEW
- On Saturday, Nov. 19, from 7 am until 6 pm, NB I-135 will be CLOSED at the North Junction. All northbound traffic will exit to EB K-254. To return to NB I-135, traffic can exit at 45<sup>th</sup> St. and flaggers will direct them to WB K-254 then they can exit onto NB I-135. Crews will relocate barrier walls for future construction work. NEW
- A new 13'9" height restriction on SB I-135 under SB I-235 is in effect.
- An 11' width restriction has been posted on WB K-254 to SB I-235.

- A long-term 11' width restriction on the two lanes of SB I-135, 53<sup>rd</sup> St. to south of the I-235/K-254, is in effect (along with a 50-mph work zone speed limit).
- 2. Pavement patching on K-96, east of Webb Road to U.S. 54 PROJECT COMPLETED Repairs to driving surface and ramps of K-96 from east of Webb Road to U.S. 54.
- 3. Repair of the WB U.S. 54 bridge at the K-251 junction (far western Sedgwick County), began on May 2. Single lane traffic for each direction of U.S. 54 for one mile will be in place until completion (November). The 383<sup>rd</sup> St. On Ramp to WB U.S. 54 will be closed for the duration of the project (with a marked detour in place).
  - Single lane traffic for each direction of U.S. 54, with crossovers, is in place.
  - The 383<sup>rd</sup> St. On Ramp to WB U.S. 54 is closed.
